



## Central Art

Previously something of a local event attached to the Marylebone Summer Favre, now London's largest street-fair, the 7th Art in Marylebone (14 to 16 June) is beginning to spread its wings. Now no longer confined to artists living or working in the borough (though still very much part of the Summer Fayre), it has been inviting applications from all artists and has also acquired a handsome venue in the Hellenic Centre in Paddington Street, along with 24 purposedesigned stands. I have a feeling this is very much a fair on the up and up; yet it appears almost as an upstart when compared to the venerable Chelsea Art Society, celebrating its 66th re-incarnation this month with over 500 paintings and sculptures by members and non-members in Chelsea Old Town Hall (20 to 24 June). Founded in 1910, in Chelsea's artistic heyday, it's the only survivor of many others set up around that time but, with over 100 members, it seems to be a flourishing organization.

### One Door Opening ...

After 17 years in Fitzrovia's Percy Street, **Contemporary Applied Art** is marking its 65th birthday by taking off for an area becoming ever trendier and 'hotter', certainly for all things designery, viz Bermondsey/ Southwark, and just a (long) stone's throw from **Tate Modern.** For the opening show, 'Perspectives', independent curator Amanda Game is working with a group of patrons to nominate an established designer or maker whose work they have supported over recent years, in the selection of works for exhibition and sale.

Waterhouse & Dodd are also moving but not quite so far, leaving their home of 12 years in Cork Street for rather more spacious premises in nearby Albemarle Street towards the middle of June – the current still-life show, ending 7 June, their last in Cork Street. Not directly involved in the current brouhaha there, they are moving ahead of any possible development-prompted mass exodus of galleries ...

Meanwhile, down in Bath **bo-lee** gallery is leaving its Queen Street HQ and boldly heading for London, where it will shortly be opening up a space in Islington. 1, Queen Street, however, will remain a contemporary gallery, being taken over almost immediately by the new **Quercus Gallery** which is showing an interesting range of work by the likes of Vanessa Gardiner, Robert Woolner, Pippa Ridley and Chloe Steele.

### Lasting Impression

Ann Petherick has been flying the flag for good contemporary art in York from her in-home gallery, **Kentmere House**, for probably a lot longer than she would care to admit! Now, as in previous years, she has again been invited by the University of York to show in their King's Manor space and has put on an absolute cracker of a show. Entitled 'Lasting Impress-ions', it includes 50 original prints by 30 artists and aims at showing both the diversity of printmaking techniques and the huge skills that go into the making of an artist's print. Petherick has cast her net nationwide and come up with some really top names – Peter Ford, Hilary Paynter and H. J. Jackson among them. Meanwhile shows go on at her gallery as per our listings.

### Which Stewart?

Referring last month to the **Zimmer Stewart** Gallery's 10th birthday, I inadvertently named its director after the *Star Trek* and Shakespearian actor, Patrick Stewart, when I should, of course, have been thinking of *Rear Window* and *It's a Wonderful Life* (among many other things) actor James Stewart. Sorry!

### Wonderful Wildlife

A quick note about another excellent sounding show at the **Mall Galleries** – 'A week of Wildlife Art' (3 to 8 June). Presented by the David Shepherd Wildlife Foundation and covering all four exhibition spaces, the main event is the shortlist for the £10,000 Wildlife Artist of the Year Prize: all works for sale and profits to endangered wildlife. With celebrity tigers in the North Gallery – famous names auction artwork







for tiger campaigns – and 'Urban Safari' from Olympic artist Jeremy Houghton, this should prove quite an event . . .

## Testament of Truth

Leon Kossoff is notoriously reticent and self-effacing, genuinely expecting his work to be done in front of the subject rather than in front of the microphone. The current exhibition of some 90 drawings and 10 paintings on two floors at **Annely Juda**, 'London Landscapes', is a rare opportunity for the visitor to witness Kossoff's very particular and powerful response to aspects and areas of a city which has been a crucial inspiration throughout his life.

From early pieces such as *Willesden Junction* (1962) to the more recent King's Cross and Arnold Circus charcoals and pastels, Kossoff's focus always seems to have been on the 'state of emergency', to use Euan Uglow's expression, that underlies the act of drawing or painting. In these portrayals of an everchanging, never resting London it finds its quietus in a way that is almost breathtakingly appropriate. I cannot imagine a more impressive testament of truth.

## Continuing The Line

Some names have a particular resonance and if there is one that rings out above all the others in the crowded St lves pantheon

then it is surely Nicholson. Kate Nicholson is the daughter of Ben (his espousal of modernism/ abstraction shook not just St lves but was fundamental to the ensuing sea changes in British art) and his first wife Winifred, a painter whose still-lifes and landscapes remain a byword for the lyrical and poetic; Kate was close to them both. This eagerly awaited exhibition at **Belgrave Gallery** is her first for thirty years.

The paintings are of course, a delight: colour, fluency of line, and movement abound. Representational landscapes of Cumbria (recalling her painting trips with Winifred) give way to still-lifes where mark making has become gestural, almost notational and abstracts - rhapsodies of brushstrokes where only titles can give clues to their inception: Sun Dance, The Corn is Growing, Seasalt. When describing her work Winifred talked of 'the magic of the metamorphosis of line into movement', she wrote with the sensitivities of a painter but also as a mother who knew her daughter Pip Palmer well.

### Force of Nature

There is perhaps is only one way to describe Anthony Green, both the man and his artistic achievement – a force of nature! What this exhibition at **John Davies** – with works ranging from 1958-2013, in effect, a miniretrospective – shows to very powerful effect is that his is an art that has, essentially been driven by love a lifelong love for his wife (and fellow artist) Mary, whom he met when at art school. It infuses everything in the show with its passionate engagement in the wonders of the created world, his family, home and surroundings. Green's great gift as an artist is that far from this becoming a selfreferential art, he seems to be able to make us look at our own world with something of the same, almost reverential exuberance.

## A Creative Zeitgeist

Following last month's piece on the William Scott centenary celebrations, a note of a new and intriguing exhibition of his work at Osborne Samuel. Entitled 'William Scott and his Friends', it consists of works from Scott's private collection that were the result of 'trades' with his painter friends. Though trained in a prewar milieu, Scott arrived at his artistic maturity in the immediate post-war period, in a zeitgeist of intense modernist, abstract fervour and this exhibition, with pieces by Antoni Tapies, Patrick Heron, Roger Hilton and Terry Frost among others, gives a still wonderfully potent feeling of the mood and spirit of that hugely excitina moment.

#### From Late Hellenistic marble torsos to Rodin bronzes via Baroque terracottas: Flemish altarpieces to Augustus John portraits via Canaletto Venetian views and Cuyp cows; German Renaissance drawings to Signac watercolours and Contemporary photography via the French Rococo: the newly formed London Art Week (28 June to 5 July) represents the most tremendous coming together of all London's major Old Master, Drawing and Sculpture dealers that's yet been seen.

What's happened, essentially, is that two previously separate set-ups, Master Drawings Week (now in its thirteenth year) and Master Paintings Week (now into its fifth), have decided to join forces while adding into the mix, for the first time, a Sculpture Week as well. The outcome is, indeed, a stunning display of strength with some 50 galleries, all concentrated in the Bond Street/St James's area, putting on a show of their finest things, the rationale for which is that it also coincides with **Sotheby's**, **Christie's** and **Bonhams** major summer auctions.

As my opening words indicated this really isn't just about dealers getting out their best Old Master paintings for the summer, as the range of what's on view is remarkably wide these days - one of the reasons that London remains so very much the focal point of the international art market is its continuing ability to adapt to a constantly changing environment, to reinvent itself in short. The other point that really does need to be made here is that this is not just a marketing ploy by dealers that are always there to be visited anyway - for example, a good proportion of those showing are private

dealers who are using the occasion to show in the spaces of other friendly galleries. In addition to which some are presenting special shows for the occasion. For instance, **Richard Green** is holding an exhibition entitled *Three Hundred Years of Portraiture and Conversation Pieces*, from Cornelius Johnson in the 17th Century to Sir Alfred Munnings in the 20th Century.

So, all in all, it really should prove the most intriguing of occasions, rather like a wonderfully eclectic art exhibition but which, instead of being held in just one gallery can be tracked down via a variety of often distinctly handsome locations. But you get to choose how to put it together – and what riches to choose from.

# art in the SOUTH & EAST



Ann Johnson 'Striped Pot' Hop Gallery

Forgotten Victorian masters, open studios, re-evaluated 60s artists, top-notch gallery shows it's all going on at the moment. Just to give it some shape and order let's start at the far southwestern end of the region in Winchester and work our way round eastwards. There one of the cathedral city's longest established commercial galleries. Minster, is mounting a very lively looking Summer Show, featuring this month the vivid abstract work of the London based French artist Marc-Antoine Goulard together with a very good overview of the wide range of artists, both figurative and abstract in character, which the gallery always has in stock -Heath Hearn, Raziye Palmer and Margaret McLellan are just some of the names that caught my eye.

While you are in this part of the world, do make an expedition to the lovely small town of Alresford, just 6 or 7 miles east of Winchester, up the Itchen Valley, where the **Jane Fuest Gallery** shows a really strong selection of contemporary paintings, ceramics and sculpture.

If it's the latter you're particularly interested in, you could always make a slightly longer journey to another small riverside town, Stockbridge on the River Test where, despite the place's obsession with all things angling-oriented, the **Garden Gallery** outside the town has a special focus this month on contemporary stone sculpture for the garden.

Now, moving eastward into Surrey, we find the diversity really clicking in - whoever said it was suburban and commuteroriented? Key event here is the Surrey Artists Open Studios annual 'open house' event which happens over the three central weekends of June. viz 8-23. and in some cases at weekdays in between as well. With 146 individual sites. some with multiple studio spaces, this probably means something like 170-180 artists spread right across this often surprisingly beautiful and remote county. To help you focus there is a really comprehensive website with an interactive map (see their listing for details).

Meanwhile for something very different, the wonderfully refurbished Watts Gallery at Compton continues its excellent special exhibition programme with a show dedicated to a great forgotten Victorian, Frank Holl RA. Holl was a leading light of the Social Realists of the 1870/80s whose images were based on realistic observation and avoided the melodrama and stereotyping of earlier generations - his Newgate; Committed for Trial one of the areat masterpieces of the movement. Turning later to portraiture he was so successful that he literally worked himself to death by 43. This is the first retrospective of his work in a century and shows a great

cross-section of his key pieces.

Not far east again from here and you are across the border into East Sussex. Head down south to the delightfully arty town of Lewes where painter Ann Johnson is showing her bold and colourfully semiabstract landscape and garden pieces at the Hop Gallery, a handsome space in the old Star Brewery. The other particular feature of this show are the new poem cards she has produced in collaboration with the Anglesev based poet Fiona Owen, for whose new book, 'A Screen of Brightness' (itself a collaboration with another poet Meredith Andrea) she has recently done the front cover.

Now continue further south-east again, right down to Udimore near Rye, where the gifted and prolific printmaker **Brenda Hartill**, is opening her beautiful home and studio to show a wide variety of work from some 30 years, over two June weekends (15-16 and 22-23) as part of the Northiam & Rye (Two Valleys) Art Trail. With the gardens of Great Dixter nearby what a nice expedition that makes . . .

A major event in the eastern region this month is Goldmark Gallery's show of R.B. Kitaj's prints: with the British Museum. Pallant House and the Jewish Museum's current major exhibitions of Kitaj's work doing a great deal to restore a reputation that had been somewhat in decline since his death in 2007 (following some severe critical maulings), this is a splendid opportunity for collectors to get in on the moment. Kitaj was always a superb, virtuoso printmaker and the 100 or so examples Mike Goldmark has brought together show clearly why he is regarded as such.

Finally, to coincide with the Aldeburgh Festival, Fulham gallery owner **Piers Feetham** holds his annual show of paintings, sculpture and ceramics at his home in the seaside town. Nicholas Usherwood

# THUMBnails

"There is no death. Only a change of worlds." Chief Seattle

#### George Catlin at the National Portrait Gallery

In May 1830 President Jackson signed the controversial Indian Removal Act – it disenfranchised Native Americans of their tribal lands to the west of the Mississippi River ensuring the expansion of European settlers. In the same year an ex lawyer and passionate advocate of the Native American way of life set out to visit and paint the last unaffected days of America's indigenous people.

George Catlin spent almost his whole life in this pursuit nearly bankrupting himself more than once in the process and ending his days in poverty, but his admiration of the many tribes of Indians he met and his disquiet at their treatment drove him on to complete a unique, poignant and artistic legacy now housed in the Smithsonian Museum.

Catlin was a self taught artist and his work is naive areat painterly technique there is not – but it vibrantly records, in real time. Native American dress and customs with an anthropologist's attention to detail. The portraits sing with vivid colour, every feather, bead and personal decoration, weapons of war and decorated buffalo skin clothing, pipes and papooses all perfectly inscribed along with the notes of who they were and what they did. When Catlin toured his show in 1839 along with the pictures came his extensive collection of Indian artifacts - even without this ingredient it is a journey well worth taking - the weight and the sadness of their history is heavy but made bearable by the joy of Catlin's delight and enthusiasm for his subjects.
