Penwith Revamped

Founded by leading modernists Hepworth and Nicholson in the 40s but now refurbished and extended, the Penwith Galleries are once again major players in the topography of St Ives. Finds such as a forgotten Althea Garstin painting and a John Milne sculpture have added to the excitement of the redevelopment, but for its members it is the accessibility of the new space which includes a main gallery for monthly mixed exhibitions, the extensive long gallery showing in May paintings by John Piper and Michael Praed, the small studio gallery for work by previous members and the revitalized sculpture garden and café that puts Penwith back on the map and reaffirms its historic and ongoing significance to the story of art in St Ives.

A Fragment in Time

Operating as a non-profit making art gallery centre, chiefly through the holiday letting of the imaginatively restored farm buildings nearby has, artistically-speaking, given **Kestle Barton** certain freedoms in programming and, since it opened a couple of seasons back, the kind of shows it mounts have taken on an increasingly adventurous character. 2014's emphasis is on contemporary artists willing to engage with the

specifics of its remote and beautiful rural locale close to the Helford River on the Lizard peninsula in Cornwall. The first show, by installation artist Lucy Willow seems an inspired choice. Starting on the project two years ago, Willow spent much of her time in Frenchman's Creek, just 5 minutes walk away and a place (for all its du Maurier connections) of unchanged, ethereal stillness and romantic isolation.

A sculptor by training, Willow made the radical decision to start making drawings using Chinese inks and brushes. Inspired by the death of two goldfinches that had flown into the gallery's windows, it becomes a quietly moving meditation on death and materiality, the drawings on paper having been translated into a continuous, semi-abstracted landscape, drawn in black Chinese inks directly around the gallery walls.

At the heart of this landscape and giving it its crucial focus, is a small drawn animation of a dying, and then disintegrating, goldfinch projected on to the landscape – a moment of transience paradoxically exhilarating in its intense remembrance of life.

As du Maurier observed in Frenchman's Creek, "And all this is only momentary, is only a fragment in time that will never come again".

Thirty Years On

Some thirty years ago Ruth Lambert and her son Andrew bought the Wesleyan Chapel in Machynlleth and started converting it into a hugely successful performing arts auditorium that opened two years later. Then, 6 years on, in 1992, they added an art gallery, MoMA Wales. Despite its title -Museum of Modern Art - it wasn't welcomed by the public gallery sector in Wales and has largely remained outside that particular pale ever since, its collecting policies seen as too figurative in character. Despite all that, their splendid permanent collection now totals over 200 works by Welsh born or resident artists and badly needs somewhere where at least part of it can be permanently on show at any given time, currently impossible since the existing spaces are needed for the programme of temporary exhibitions that runs throughout the year, so they are busy converting a neighbouring building, The Tannery. One part will be a dedicated Sculpture Space, the other a gallery but there had to be one! - to finish the work off they need another £130.000. An appeal has been launched: see their website for details - and, if you haven't been. do go to see the place - 25,000 a year do already . . .





Jankel Adler

Born in Łodz in Poland in 1895, Jankel Adler transfixes us in a 1926 portrait by Otto Dix with his fiercely quizzical, dark-eyed, prophetic regard. Living in Düsseldorf in 1922, Adler had befriended Paul Klee, and later in Paris knew Picasso. Finding refuge in Scotland in 1941, living later in London, he inspired and tremendously enriched British artists such as Colquhoun, MacBryde, Vaughan and Clough with his exploratory continental avant-gardism.

Focussing on his final years in Britain, where he died in 1949. the exhibition at the Goldmark Gallery (until 25 July) of over 100 oils, watercolours and drawings, reveals his marvellously sensitive. humane achievement seen in taut, thrilling abstracts; ecstatic still lifes in which each artefact is distinct with vivid potency: and a 1947 series of delicate semi-abstract watercolours where poignant, diaphanous figures, eerily pineyed and angularly abstracted, are choreographed in a disquietingly playful, harrowing post-Holocaust no-man's-land. Matthew Draper

Scotland has produced many renowned itinerant artists – from David Roberts and Andrew Melville to Boyle Family and Barbara Rae. Matt Draper is a

peripatetic successor to this nomadic tradition with his constant need to seek and engage with new geographical and geological vistas. His recent travels have taken him to Skye (The Misty Isle) and the rugged terrain of the Cuillin Ridge. Such mountainous magnificence has inspired a series of evocative pastel and austere charcoal drawings. Draper has skilfully mastered these graphic mediums on an impressive scale which involve such a high degree of manual dexterity that the practice hovers between painting and modelling. This direct physical contact is essential in order that the artist can fully convey the exhilarating experience of being a keenly receptive presence in such a magical place, where the echoes of history mingle with the ever-changing patterns of light and shadow. (Open Eye Gallery until 14 May.) **Bill Hare**

Alternative Strategies

For all the growth of a stronger regional gallery system over the last decade, artists seem ever more intent on taking matters into their own hands, witness the astonishing rise of the 'Open Studio' movement since 2000 – there seem to be few districts in the UK without one. This month we have notice of at least half a dozen – and those are just ones who have contacted us. Initially they seemed to follow the county-wide model e.g **Cornwall**

Open Studios (24 May to 1 June) or Surrey Artists Open Studios (taster shows in May. open studios 7 to 22 June) with 150 plus participants. In recent years, though, a more 'local' tendency has become apparent, smaller groups of 25-50 artists from a limited geographical area. Pilgrims Way Artists, actually founded in 1996 in Lenham, Kent and one of the earliest of its kind. has just 25 members. It doesn't do 'open studios' as such, but holds an annual show in the village's magnificent tithe barn (16 to 26 May). Similarly with Teddington Artists - just 16 of them – showing in the National Physical Laboratory atrium in Bushy Park. Crouch End Open Studios, as their name suggests, do - some 30 of them - on the weekend of 10/11 May with a preview show in Hornsey Library 1 to 15 May. Finally a very different model again. Second Floor Studios and Arts in Greenwich, a huge single site complex that aims to provide affordable studio spaces (250 of them) for London's increasingly hard-pushed (economically speaking) artist and design community, next opening 15, 17/18 May. What diversity and what opportunities: do let us know if you have an event later in the summer . . .

FOCUS SCULPTURE

inside and out





2014 is the centenary of Lynn Chadwick's birth and his longtime dealers Osborne Samuel are celebrating the occasion with a retrospective at which Michael Bird's comprehensive monograph on the sculptor will be launched. Chadwick trained as an architectural draughtsman and his rise to fame in the early 1950's started with him making mobiles and stabiles for building trade fairs. His approach was one of construction rather than modelling and his welded spiky pieces chimed perfectly with the 'new vernacular' that made its mark at the Venice Biennale of 1952. Alongside Armitage, Butler, Clarke and others, Chadwick was responsible for forging a distinctive modernist language that gave British sculpture a new and invigorating, if slightly abrasive, voice.

Pangolin London's presence at Kings Place is a boon for the capital's sculpture lovers. The affiliation with the foundry enables them to work closely with the artists, not only in the development of their work but also in running sculpture residencies. Pieces by recent residents, Abigail Fallis and Briony Marshall, are included in the Sculpture Trail that weaves in and out of the building (until 2 August). Arm yourself with the pamphlet to avoid missing such gems as Charlotte Mayer's 'Rising' or Geoffrey Clarke's 'Battersea II and III', which from a distance seem to be part of the


nautical paraphernalia of the canal side. In the gallery itself the beautifully conceived and arranged 'Sculpture in the Home' shows small scale sculpture in a domestic environment. Putting on such multi-disciplinary exhibitions is more to be expected of a public gallery with their greater resources, but the results, especially for fans of the 50's look, is tremendous. Maybe it'll inspire the current crop of students across the way at Central St Martins (with whom Pangolin have established links, particularly in the field of ceramics) to try and rival the creativity of that golden age.

At Sladmore Contemporary, as part of the annual exhibition of the Society of Portrait Sculptors, there's a chance to see Martin Jennings' maquette for the 3m statue of Mary Seacole due to be prominently sited in the grounds of St Thomas' hospital, amid much hue and cry over whether her contribution to nursing has been over-hyped at the expense of other deserving candidates. (The Scottish-Creole volunteer ran the 'British Hotel', a restaurant-cumstore for convalescing officers in the Crimean War.) This rather unfashionable form of sculpture should get a boost with the current interest in the Great War: there's already a project, 'Letter to an Unknown Soldier', encouraging us to imagine what Jagger's Tommy on Platform 1 of Paddington station is reading. SD

When sculpture parks first emerged post-war, the idea was essentially of a permanent museum collection that happened to be out-of-doors and only rarely changed. By the 80s revolution was afoot with, on the one hand Gilbert Cass's Sculpture Foundation at Goodwood, where all the displayed pieces were for sale/commission and changed annually, on the other, the Yorkshire Sculpture Park at Bretton Hall, where it was presented as a sequence of temporary, but outside, curated exhibitions. Now, in Tremenheere, we have what may well become the model for the 21st C., a place where the 'park' element of the term takes on equal significance with the sculpture, not just a nice backdrop. Both the place and the work are extraordinary - an ancient, richly wooded valley rippling with streams that opens onto a spectacular view of St Michael's Mount and Mount's Bay. For the owner, since 1997, Neil Armstrong, a Penzance GP, this has been the starting point, his passion for landscape gardens and planting - largely sub-tropical - evolving steadily alongside remarkable sculptural initiatives which, as far as I can tell, have arrived almost by osmosis, certainly organically. This, by definition, means slow growth - just 11 at the last count but what sculpture and what

siting! From this spring a superb new James Turrell – a large oval skyspace – to add to his Aqua Oscura water tank and a just installed Minotaur from locally based RA Tim Shaw, a darkly massive presence glowering out from its woodland hideaway. There's also a new-ish Richard Long 'growing' piece to go with a massive David Nash, two poetic Kishio Sugas and, as the place's astonishing vision and potential become better known, exciting plans for the future.

There are, meanwhile, a number of other handsome gardens with sculpture initiatives dotted around the country this spring. Borde Hill in Hayward's Heath for example, where. through to September, 14 artists are contributing 40 pieces of work in a wonderful listed Late Victorian garden setting of recognised botanical significance. It's an eclectic but imaginatively chosen group that mixes figurative and abstract work, youthful in character and employing a wide range of materials, from stone to driftwood.

Friends of the Garden comes at the garden/sculpture idea rather the other way round, consisting of a group of volunteers (based in Wiltshire) with a passion for gardening and the understanding that introducing sculpture into the garden can completely change the way we see both nature and art – shades of Tremenheere!

They are also peripatetic. organising exhibitions in different Wiltshire gardens each summer. This year it is West Lavington where 20 artists have been invited to show in a 5 acre walled Italianate garden first established in the 17th C. and replete with a trout stream and outstanding specimen trees. Again the artists, both young and more established, are thoughtfully and imaginatively chosen as working across materials and styles (but please note this show is not open until 5-22 June).

The Garden Gallery, just over the Hampshire county border in Stockbridge, takes a different line again. A commercial enterprise established 19 years ago and representing 50 sculptors. potters and makers, they are accompanying this year's regular show with a special exhibition, entitled 'Echoes in the Memory' and inspired by T.S. Eliot's Four Quartets and the remembrance and commemoration of the First World War - how we cherish memories of the past and the stories which make our histories. Again a distinguished range of artists with a number drawn from the ranks of the Royal Society of British Artists.

Diane Coates and Andrew Sinclair have a passion for figurative sculpture which they have felt to be so badly taught in British art schools that they decided to run The Sculpture School from their Wendover base teaching its range of necessary skills via a mix of weekends and summer schools. They were also spotted by Hatfield House and given the envious task of curating this year's displays in its magnificent gardens – 70 pieces by some of Britain's best figurative sculptors in The Great British Sculpture Show.

Meanwhile back in London American-born, British-based sculptor Josie Spencer, who has enjoyed huge critical and commercial success with her dynamic Classical-archaeology inspired figures, has been invited to show a body of her work in Golden Square from May to October. Modelling in clay, breaking them apart and then casting them in bronze she achieves a remarkable synthesis of the ancient and the modern.

Finally, indoors, where, paradoxically he mostly isn't, Peter Randall-Page has a show of 'Drawings, prints and sculpture on a domestic scale' at Honiton's excellent public gallery space the Thelma Hulbert Gallery (from 10 May). Devonbased himself, Randall-Page chose this space as providing the ideal platform for showing this important new exhibition, one which explores in depth the crucial role drawing has always played in his artistic practice, even down to the fact that he often draws directly on to the surface of the stone before carving. Lyrical and ecstatic, bursting with inner life, this is a show to travel many miles for. NU


with 170 artists now participating in what is reckoned to be the largest fair of its kind in the country - is beginning to make a significant contribution to Chelsea's wider artistic revival (see February issue of Galleries). It had over 7500 visits

in just three days last year with sales into six figures - good for artists struggling to get gallery shows and, with no commission, good for buyers too in terms of prices. This looks very much like an event that's here to stay . . . Nicholas Usherwood




The Wonder of Birds

Birds are so woven into the fabric of our cultural lives and visual imagination that the wonder is, particularly in a birdmad country like ours, that there has never, so far as I can remember anyway, been a show quite like the one opening at Norwich Castle Museum & Art Gallery later this month (from 24 May, map 16). Entitled 'The Wonder of Birds', it really covers

the subject in remarkably thorough historical depth and geographical range - over 220 items - from a Colombian shaman's necklace portraying half-human, half-bird figures that aided the trances needed for spiritual flight to a Babylonian stone duck, dating from around 2000BC, originally used as a grain weight. Not to mention Audubon, Holbein, Mantegna and plenty of taxidermy . . .

CODA

For all the vivid colours and bold forms that define his paintings, Emile Nolde (1857-1956) can be rather a shadowy figure in the history of art. However, throughout May, Connaught Brown will exhibit 10 of Nolde's watercolours alongside 12 works by his student Herbert Beck (1920-2010) in order to provide insight into the interests and inspirations of these two German Expressionists.

Nolde was an independent character during his life. While the angular faces of his figures point towards his brief association with Die Brücke artists, his works are primarily informed, absorbing interest in the land around him. It's possible to identify the elements that define Nolde's works reflected in his student's

paintings: the importance of expression through colour, the appeal of the natural world as inspiration and the beauty of the organic form.

Both worked primarily with watercolour, practicing the wetin-wet technique that Nolde had developed by applying their paints onto dampened paper. The result is scenes executed in deep jewel tones that feel both fascinating and detached. Nolde's landscapes, with dark skies, expansive fields and solitary houses are simultaneously lonely and intimate, while Beck's glowing panoramas point to his association with Nolde, while straying towards the abstract.

Nolde's pictures don't appear in London often, so Connaught Brown will use the show, which runs from 2 to 24 May, as an opportunity to display a variety of his works. In addition to Nolde's vast landscapes will be his dreamy figurative scenes, flower paintings and several of his 'unpainted pictures' – watercolours produced in secret after he was judged by the Nazis to be a 'degenerate' artist, despite being a member of the party.

Accustomed to relating contemporary art with earlier modern pieces, Connaught Brown's exhibition of the works of Nolde and Beck, two artists joined by their expressive styles and personal relationship, promises to be fascinating . . .
