

HAVE YOU SEEN . . .

Two stolen paintings
from Agi Katz at the Boundary Gallery

Almost two years ago three paintings were bought with a stolen Visa card. I only discovered this three weeks after the purchase by which time the works had been removed from the gallery.

In spite of a concerted effort to recover the £10,500 lost, I could not get anywhere.

Two weeks ago I received an email from the artist Anita Klein, whose work it was, saying that she had been contacted by a member of the public who had seen in the window of a Moroccan shop on the Harrow Road a painting which could have only been by Anita Klein (the artist has a very distinct style).

The price tag was £2,500 in a shop that only sells inexpensive items. The passer by had photographed the painting and forwarded it to Anita Klein, who, of course, instantly recognised it.

When I received Anita's email, I telephoned the police with the crime number and the address of the shop. The police seized the painting and brought it to me which I thought was amazing.

Two of the stolen paintings are still missing - can anyone help?
