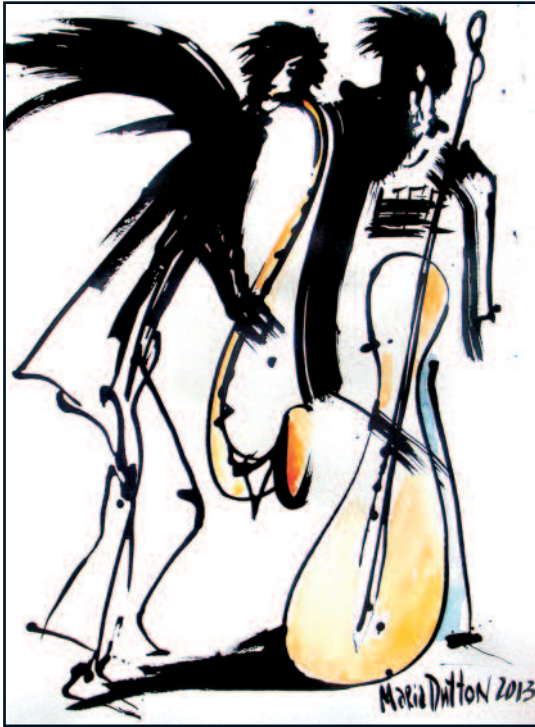

Fair News . . .

As ever, the **London Art Fair 2014** (15-19 January) kicks off the new fairs' season and is looking in good shape. To hear the latest news and see what some of the galleries will be showing at it turn to our feature on p42. Meanwhile early warning of the next one up, the always enjoyable **Works on Paper Fair** (6-9 February) at the Science Museum in Kensington. A feature on this next month, but just so you get it in your diary . . .

New Eyes on York

There's a distinctly enterprising and engaging story behind Ann Petherick's latest **Kentmere House** show in York. Entitled 'New Eyes on York' and featuring the work of Nigerian-born, Kent-based painter Adebajji Alade, its genesis lies in a visit Ann made to Bath earlier this year where she encountered Adebajji's work in a gallery and saw immediately how well his way of working would suit the York cityscape. An invitation to visit York followed during the course of which Ann took him on a brief guided tour and then left him to make his choices of subjects. He, in turn, was so excited by the place that, working 12 hours a day, he produced some 10 paintings and a whole host of pencil sketches within the week – and is going back! And now the idea is mushrooming with Adebajji

telling his social media followers about what he was doing resulting in invitations to visit several other historic cities.

January Sparkle

In a month that, understandably enough I suppose, can lack a certain buzz in London's commercial gallery scene, the **Mall Galleries** seems to be taking a very positive line with two distinctly interesting if very contrasting exhibitions. First there is the second edition of an intriguing recent enterprise, the 'FBA Futures' show (20-25 January), in which members from the various Federation of British Artists exhibiting societies resident, so to speak, at the Mall Galleries, have selected some 24 artists from the 2013 graduate and post-graduate shows to take part. Designed to highlight the wide and innovative range of approaches to figurative art that are in fact taking place in British art-schools – so often labelled largely conceptual in attitude – it is a splendidly broad show with artists from as far afield as Glasgow, Edinburgh, Newcastle and Falmouth art schools, as well as the South-East and London. A bold bid, in short, to change public perceptions and, perhaps, bring in fresh blood to the societies themselves.

Then, just a few days later, the **Catto Gallery**, in association with Marie-Aude Chepik, are presenting a major retrospective

there of a significant Russian painter of the late 20th Century, Sergei Chepik (1953-2011). Described as a 'searing visionary', his paintings of phantasmagorical and religious events in both his native Russia and in France, where he went to live in 1988, have won him a growing international reputation. This show, which covers work from both his early years in Russia and from his time in Paris, should prove quite an eye-opener, one suspects.

The Cork Street Shuffle

News in of a further reshuffling of gallery spaces in Cork Street ahead of the major works due there later in the year – **Mayor Gallery** are moving diagonally, two doors to their left and one floor up, to the First Floor of 21 Cork Street from this month on.

Looking Up

Panter & Hall have also moved recently, from cosy Shepherd's Market to the grandeur of 11-12 Pall Mall. A fantastic space with the addition of a useful basement gallery for smaller shows, this little corner of Pall Mall has become a bit of an art hub and although not always obvious from the street, the large imposing buildings and huge windows belie their outer clubland atmosphere turning to cool artiness within. Definitely worth a visit for their January

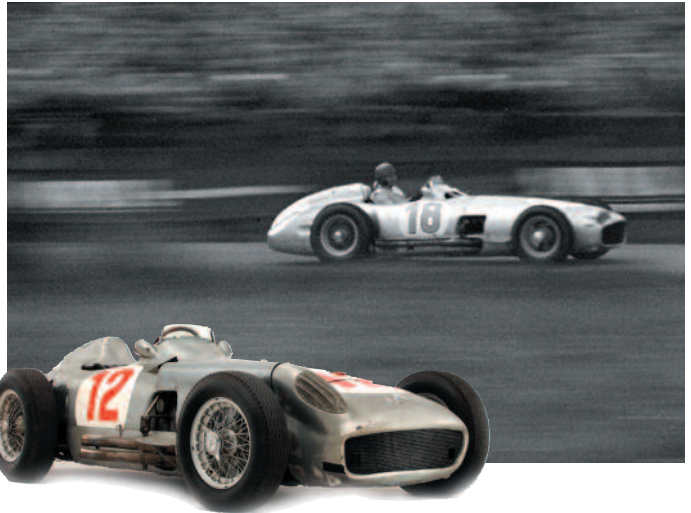


shows – Ken White’s Swindon railway landscapes first, followed by their annual exhibition of current Scottish painters. Keep a sharp look out . . .

Mandela’s Art

In all the wide-ranging coverage of Nelson Mandela’s death last month – his love of music and of sport as well as his political life – little reference that I could see to his activities as an artist.

Admittedly it was a late-flowering passion – he only started taking art lessons in 2002 – but the lithographs produced from his drawings, now to be seen at the **Belgravia Gallery**, above all those coming out of a return to Robben Island that same year, reveal just how deep the scars of his imprisonment must have been.

It was an astonishing year for the Auction Houses with the highest prices ever paid for works by both a living and deceased artists. **Sotheby’s** also recently announced an increase of 85% on their share values and one can assume a similar level of growth for **Christie’s** and **Bonhams**, though both are privately owned.

‘Silver Car Crash’ of 1963 by Andy Warhol was Sotheby’s top selling price at over \$105 million achieved in New York in November, where they also dominated the Impressionist and Modern evening sale with a total of \$290 million, twice that of Christie’s.

But it was Christie’s that won out in the Post-war and Contemporary Sales with close to \$700 million for 69 lots, twice that of their main rival. ‘Three Studies of Lucian Freud’ by Francis Bacon painted in 1969 now holds the World Record for any Work of Art, selling for a cool \$142 million. Until this sale the world record for a living artist was for a Gerhard Richter abstract but

was surpassed by Jeff Koons’ ‘Balloon Dog, Orange’, one of five in different colours and massive in size, selling for an amazing \$58.5 million.

Bonhams, who have long ruled supreme in the Motor Car and Automobile market, a particular passion for owner Robert Brooks, achieved a stunning World Record for any car with a 1954 GP Mercedes works racing car, selling for £19.5 million which was their highest price of the year, two and a half million pounds more than a Fragonard portrait.

It would seem that the growing trend for the year was for the dominance of Modern and Contemporary Art and very much with a leaning towards the narrative. This is as a result of the lack of supply and ownership problems in the Impressionist and Modern Market. With instant access to information on living artists, this area would appear to be a sounder option for the super-rich and a safer investment with a fashion that will continue throughout 2014 . . .



PUBLIC EYE



Beating Sad . . .

Seasonal Affective Disorder, that is, for which, given the number of excellent public gallery shows on through January, or much of it, there is now no excuse art-wise. Time was when most of the big London spaces tended to shut their main shows as soon as the Christmas holidays were over, but some at least do seem to have learnt the lesson and the city is still surprisingly full of some brilliant things to see. Where to start? The **Royal Academy** perhaps, where the great 19th C. French Realist painter and social commentator Daumier has his first major London show in over half a century. I remember the first, as an art-history student, at the old Tate, when his astoundingly sharp and satirical caricatures, nailing the political corruptions and social pretensions of both the Louis-Philippe and Napoleon III's Second Empire regimes, chimed perfectly with the mood of the Swinging 60s, *Beyond the Fringe* and all that! Then he largely disappeared from view which makes this new show most welcome and, at a moment of ever-widening wealth gaps and anodyne social commentary, more than timely. The paintings and sculptures are equally remarkable, observing and chronicling the everyday lives of the poor, cholera epidemics and all, on the one hand and themes of judgement, spectatorship and

reverie on the other, with a profound human sympathy. No wonder Baudelaire regarded him as one of the most important men 'in the whole of modern art', while his influence is to be found in the work of artists from Degas through Picasso and Bacon to Rego, Kentridge and Blake in our own time.

Meanwhile over at the **Barbican** that wonderful moment in the late 50s, 60s and early 70s, when the West finally threw off the doom and gloom of the immediate post-war period and exuberantly embraced modern material culture, is splendidly celebrated in their current winter show 'Pop Art Design'. All the big names from both sides of the Atlantic are here – Warhol, Oldenburg, Lichtenstein Judy Chicago and the Eames Brothers in the USA, Blake, Hamilton, Allen Jones and Tilson in the UK and Sotsass, Ettore Pesce and Castiglione in Europe – though the emphasis here is much less on the fine art side of things and much more on exploring Pop Art's integral relationship to design – something that, remarkably enough, hasn't ever really been done before. In that sense its influence is still very much with us at a time when the boundaries between art, architecture and design are more porous and dynamically creative, in the UK at least, than ever. The good old 60s took up the

Modernist initiative and ran with it – a stunning show!

Finally some reminders about shows we have covered an edition or two back that are still on through the month, or are in fact closing during its course. Most notable among the former is the very handsome show at **Ben Uri**, 'Up roar!', which, as part of its centenary celebrations this year, commemorates the first 50 years of The London Group (1913-63) with 50 works by 50 artists. Epstein, Bomberg, Nevinson, Moore and Lowry are among the luminaries and with museum quality loans this is a show absolutely not to be missed. In the same category is **Tate Modern**'s Paul Klee show, discussed last month, while among the significant shows that are closing in January, the **National Gallery**'s handsome Viennese portrait exhibition, 'Facing the Modern' ends on the 12th, as does **Dulwich**'s excellent 'Whistler and the Thames'. Further afield, do try to catch **Pallant House**'s tremendous Sean Scully show of triptych pieces from the last 40 years before it finishes on 26 January. And by then it's nearly February and 'can Spring be far behind?' – especially after all that art . . .

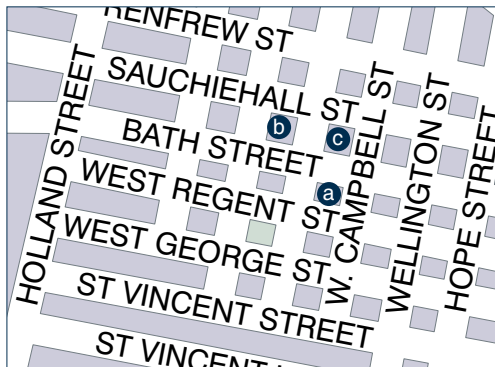

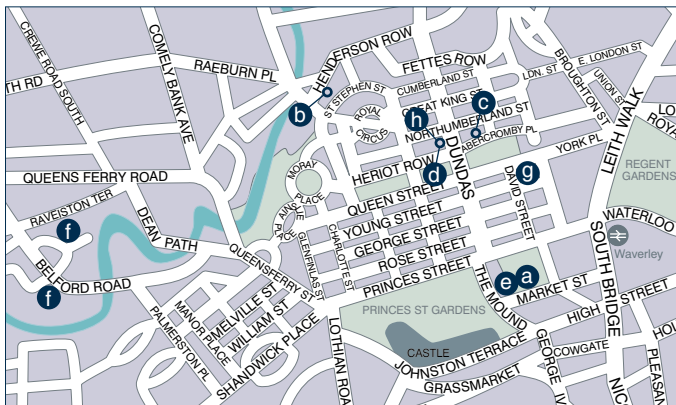

It might be beside the sea but **Slader's Yard** seems to be taking no notice of the fact that it's high winter, having launched, just before Christmas (and running to late February), what they grandly proclaim as "an all-star rolling exhibition . . . of highly regarded West Country landscape painters." With artists of the calibre of Alf Stockham, Julian Bailey, Simon Garden and Janette Kerr among them, this is no idle claim either – there are

some really gorgeous things here. The ones that caught my particular fancy, as careful readers of this magazine over the years won't be surprised to hear, is Alf Stockham's group, in particular *Harvest Moon*. A huge, red moon hovers above a looming black rectangle – a pier end? – against a sunset sky of greeny apricot shading to warm green. Figurative? Abstract? Who cares! (see map 11)

 JMW Turner bestrides 19th Century British art – arguably all British art – as such a Colossus (to purloin a phrase) that it is easy to forget that in his lifetime he could be described as “the great sea painter” and that he adopted a “somewhat sailor-like” persona. Indeed as the curators of the extensive National Maritime Museum exhibition (until 21 April 2014) point out, he

Painted the sea in its multifarious moods more frequently than any other subject. It remained a central preoccupation throughout his career, from *Fishermen at Sea* (1796) to *The Fighting Temeraire* (1839) – recently voted Britain's favourite painting – and beyond. This handsome publication, the catalogue to the NMM show, combines an excellent contextual overview with in-depth analysis of important works, many of them displayed in close up detail.

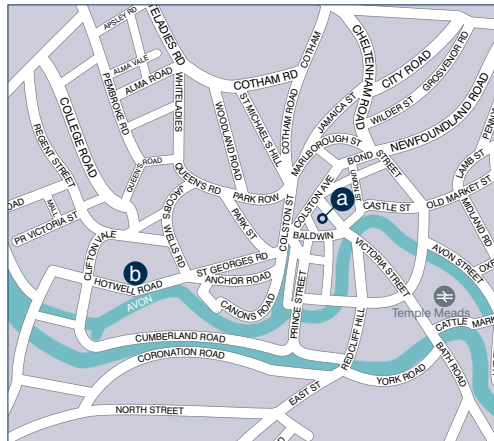

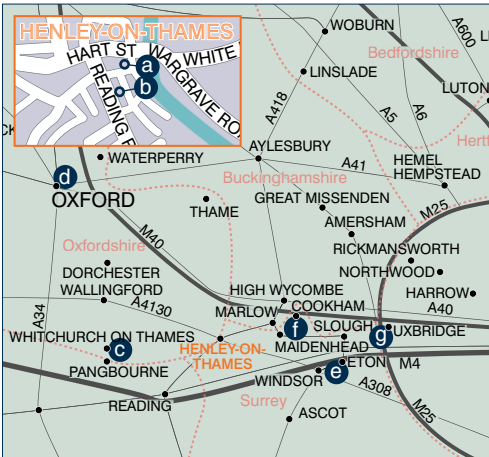

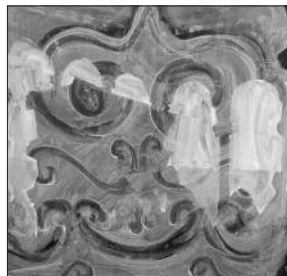

donors and the Mayor of London matching the Chancellor's contribution, more than half of its projected £150m costs are already accounted for. This exciting project is really beginning to look less and less of a pipe-dream.

It was clear from informal conversations at the reception that Heatherwick was also very keen this wasn't going to become just another *grand projet*, indicating that he felt it was absolutely vital that a substantial part of the bridge's costs should be met through public subscription, because only in this way would the general public, and Londoners

in particular, take full ownership of the whole scheme and feel it was truly theirs. Watch this space . . .

Still with the Critics' Circle (it covers drama, music, film and dance as well), which celebrated its 100th birthday in 2013, the anniversary year also recently saw its annual overall award go to a visual artist for the first time, Grayson Perry RA (of Reith Lectures fame) beating the distinguished likes of Nicholas Hytner and Jim Broadbent. No-one can say the visual arts are a minority interest anymore . . .

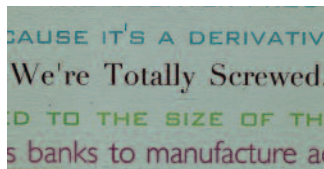

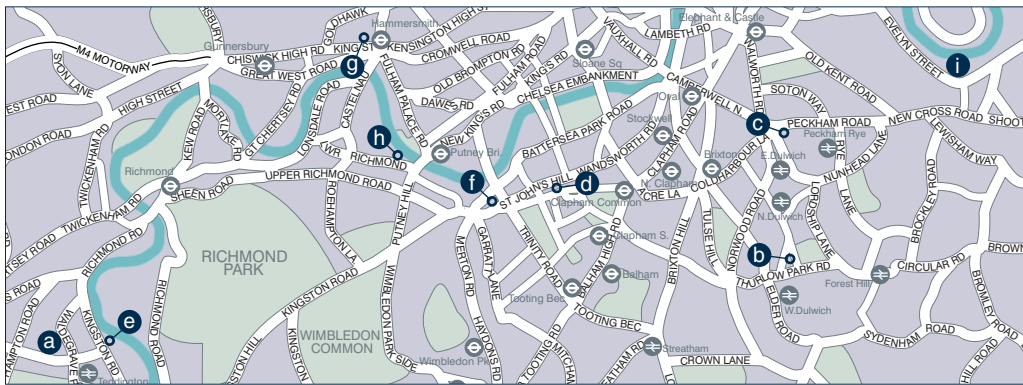

How can, or should, a visual artist take on something so apparently intractable as the recent financial crisis? Well, Larry McGinity has come up with some interesting, thoroughly researched angles for his new show at **Hay Hill**. Honing an estimated half-million words of financial books and journalism into some 20,000 and dividing the subject into 14 themed canvases with titles like *Fiscal*

Criminality, Federal Reserve and *Bad Loans*, McGinity turned these texts into laser-cut stencils through which spray paint has been applied in abstract patterns that also echo the electronic forms with which traders would be familiar. Meanwhile, playing with texts both ancient and modern in origin, he has come up with some surprisingly effective artistic and polemical solutions. (see map 23 & the cover.) **NU**

While the international contemporary and secondary art-market seems to have been largely impervious to the economic slowdown of recent years, conditions have remained pretty tough for almost everyone else, so it will be interesting to see if the Chancellor's recent optimism about upturns, growth etc begins to translate into better times for the British market.

With 128 participating galleries and the full range of Art Projects and Photo 50 sub-sections alongside, together with a whole host of talks and events, many of them sponsored by publisher Lund Humphries (not to mention sponsorship of the Fair itself), which is celebrating its 75th birthday this year, the signs look promising. Something that introducing a new Champagne Bar into the mix might seem to underline . . .
