After the show in Paris in 2007, Kosturi is presenting a new series of informal paintings in his signature medium of acrylic on canvas and print at his first London exhibition.

"Unwiped Windows" takes us to Verona or perhaps any other city in the world, where on old walls and windows one can see a mark of passing time, the emotions embedded with a smudge of a finger or an incise of a stone or a key. The multiple layers of colour remind of the paint on the walls, that scrape off, and while in destruction, reveal a testimony of the past, of romance and of long gone glamour. In the same time, almost to contradict the destruction, all the layers and writing combine together to let the beauty reemerge from beneath.

Kosturi speaks of his work: "My intention is to glorify the contrast of volatile words and thoughts written on walls; to symbolize the marking of our existence; to defend the vulnerability and yet the eternal strength of our passions: pure ideas and dreams."

Painter and poet, Endri Kosturi, was born in Tirana, Albania in 1980. Having grown up in Italy, he currently lives and works in London. For many years he has experimented with different techniques and mediums, figurative and non-figurative. He has exhibited regularly in Milan, Trieste and Paris and his work has been acquired by private collectors throughout Europe. "Unwiped Windows" represents Kosturi's premiere in the UK, as this is his first London show.
