

In just four years since returning home to become a professional artist in 2003, Jamie has already hosted numerous sell-out art exhibitions in Edinburgh since then. His artworks can be seen in a selection of well-known galleries throughout the UK and in many exclusive private and corporate collections across Europe, the USA and Hong Kong. Jamie was also a recent finalist for the prestigious *Jolomo Lloyds TSB Scotland Awards 2007* for his outstanding artworks of the Scottish landscape.
