


Forest Interior

In his forth major exhibition with The Scottish Gallery, Alexander Fraser has produced enigmatic works of a lush, haunting beauty, drawing on the artist's experiences in the rainforests of Mexico, Guatemala and Honduras, but composed from the perspective of his native Muchalls in Aberdeenshire. In many works the artist figure is seen, sketchpad in hand, seeking his subject and inspiration, adding an underlying narrative.

Born in Aberdeen, the artist studied and later taught at Gray's School of Art in Aberdeen, where he was Head of Drawing and Painting for ten years until 1997.
